Technical areas include trip generation, transportation impacts analysis, transportation planning, transportation engineering, traffic safety, transportation operations, and connected/automated vehicles.

In addition to providing technical support, this intern will help ITE staff, implementing strategies intended to improve the overall membership experience for student members of ITE.
